Agastachys odorata	e	fragrant candlebush	shrub to 3m high; leaves hairless, oblong, to 8cm long; white flowers in erect spikes up to 12cm long
Allocasuarina zephyrea	e	western sheoak	shrub to 2m; leaves are small teeth on needle-like branchlets; flowers m & f separate; cones to 3.5cm
Amperea xiphioclada		broom spurge	almost leafless with angles stems, forms clumps resembling grass tussock
Anodopetalum biglandulc	e	horizontal	shrub, or tree to 15m high; trunk usually bends over; leaves opposite, narrow elliptical, to 6cm long; flowers 4-petalled, cream/pale green
Anopterus glandulosus	e	tasmanian laurel	shrub/small tree to 4m; leaves glossy, to 17cm; flowers in clusters, 6-petalled, bell shaped, white/pink
Aotus ericoides		golden pea	shrub to 1.5m; leaves narrow to 12mm long, margins downrolled; yellow pea flower with red throat
Archeria eriocarpa	e	hairy rainforest-heath	shrub to 2.5m high; leaves to 9mm long, elliptical, edges finely toothed; flowers tubular, white/pink, to 7mm long

<i>Coprosma quadrifida</i>		native currant	erect shrub to 4m; leaves to 10mm; flowers, male & female on separate plants, 4 white petals; fruit shiny red/orange
<i>Drosera binata</i>		forked sundew	herb; leaves forked, on long stem, blades with glistening hairs; flowers white, to 2cm diam, in groups of up to 40
<i>Drosera pygmaea</i>		dwarf sundew	tiny carnivorous herb; leaves round, fringed with hairs, in basal rosette; tiny single white flower
<i>Epacris curtisiae</i>	e	northwest heath	shrub to 1m high; to 6mm long, edges transparent, tip pointed; flowers white, tubular
<i>Epacris impressa</i>		common heath	shrub; white, red or pink tubular flowers with dimples at base
<i>Epacris lanuginosa</i>		swamp heath	erect narrow shrub to 1.5m; leaves narrow lance-shaped with sharp point; flowers white, tubular in clusters
<i>Eucalyptus obliqua</i>		stringybark	tree to 90m; trunk & branches covered in soft, ridged bark; leaves very unsymmetrical;
<i>Eucryphia lucida</i>	e	leatherwood	tree to 12m; leaves green above whitish below, ends blunt; flowers with 4 rounded white petals & numerous reddish stamens
<i>Eucryphia milliganii</i>	e	dwarf leatherwood	shrub/small tree to 3m high; leaves opposite, oblong, shiny green above, whitish under; flowers white with numerous showy burgundy-tipped stamens

<i>Melaleuca squarrosa</i>		scented paperbark	shrub/tree to 6m; leaves to 8mm, ovate, pointed; flowers yellow/cream in terminal bottle brushes
<i>Monotoca glauca</i>		goldey wood	shrub to 3m; leaves to 10mm, sharp points; flowers white, 5 petalled, in small groups
<i>Nematolepis squamea</i>		satinwood	shrub/tree to 4 m; leaves to 8 cm, green upper surface, silvery below; flowers white/cream, 5 petals with prominent stamens.
<i>Nothofagus cunninghamii</i>		myrtle beech	tree to 50m; leaves roundish, new growth red; flowers inconspicuous
<i>Oxylobium arborescens</i>		tall shaggypea	shrub to 6m; leaves to 8cm. edges turned down, dark green above, silky under; pea flowers golden, in clusters

<i>Tasmannia lanceolata</i>		mountain pepper	tree to 5m; leaves lance-shaped on red stems; flowers yellow; fruit red turning black
<i>Blechnum nudum</i>		fishbone waterfern	fronds light green divided only once, fertile fronds different
<i>Blechnum wattsi</i>		hard waterfern	fronds dark green, divided only once, fertile fronds different
<i>Dicksonia antarctica</i>		soft treefern	Tall fern, trunks to several metres tall
<i>Microsorium pustulatum</i>		kangaroo fern	growing on trunks of other plants or rocks
<i>Polystichum proliferum</i>		mother shieldfern	note bulbils (new FERN) on fronds
<i>Pteridium esculentum</i>		bracken	common fern to 2.5m tall; leathery much divided frond
<i>Baloskion tetraphyllum</i>		southern cordrush	rush to 1m; leaves replaced by brown sheaths along flowering stems; flowers in terminal clusters
<i>Chiloglottis cornuta</i>		green bird-orchid	orchid with pair of opposite, broad ovate leaves; flowers green, on scapes to 4cm high
<i>Dianella tasmanica</i>		forest flaxlily	perennial to 1.5m; leaves long, narrow, margins serrated; flowers on long stalks, 6-petalled, blue; fruit a blue/purple shiny berry
<i>Diplarrena moraea</i>		white flag-iris	strap-like leaves; white flowers

<i>Isophysis tasmanica</i>	e	tasmanian purplestar	herb to 30cm high; leaves tapered, in fan-shaped tufts, flowers purple, star-shaped, on stem longer than leaves

shrub to 3m high; leaves hairless, oblong, to 8cm long; white flowers in erect spikes up to 12cm long



GJ [Allocasuarina zephyrea](#)

western sheoak

shrub to 2m; leaves are small teeth on needle-like branchlets; flowers m & f separate; cones to 3.5cm



GJ [Amperea xiphioclada](#)

broom spurge

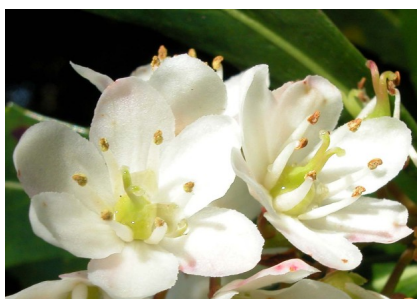
almost leafless with angles stems, forms clumps resembling grass tussock



RW [Anodopetalum biglandulosum](#)

horizontal

shrub, or tree to 15m high; trunk usually bends over; leaves opposite, narrow elliptical, to 6cm long; flowers 4-petalled, cream/pale green



GJ [Anopterus glandulosus](#)

tasmanian laurel
shrub/small tree to 4m; leaves glossy, to 17cm; flowers in clusters, 6-petaled, bell shaped, white/pink



GJ [Aotus ericoides](#)

golden pea
shrub to 1.5m; leaves narrow to 12mm long, margins down-rolled; yellow pea flower with red throat



GJ [Archeria eriocarpa](#)

hairy rainforest-heath
shrub to 2.5m high; leaves to 9mm long, elliptical, edges finely toothed; flowers tubular, white/pink, to 7mm long



GJ [Aristotelia peduncularis](#)

heartberry
straggling shrub to 1.5m; leaves to 70mm, lance-shaped, edges serrated; flowers white, bell-shaped, petals three-toothed; fruit heart shaped, white, red or black



GJ [Atherosperma moschatum](#)

sassafras
tree to 25m; leaves to 8cm elliptical, margins often toothed; flowers white, in pairs, pendulous, 4-petaled. Male and female flowers on same or separate trees

silver banksia
tree with typical banksia cones or yellow flower spikes

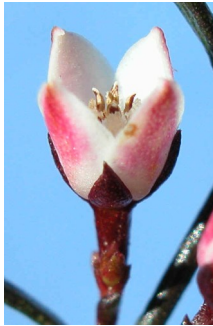

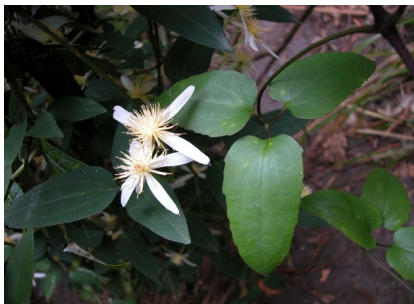

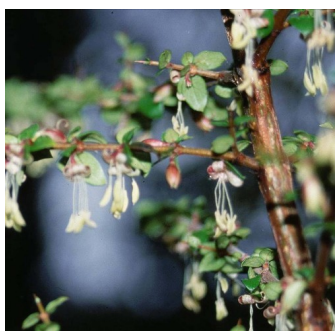

forked sundew
herb; leaves forked, on long stem, blades with glistening hairs; flowers white, to 2cm diam, in groups of up to 40



GJ [*Drosera pygmaea*](#)

dwarf sundew
tiny carnivorous herb; leaves round, fringed with hairs, in basal rosette; tiny single white flower



GJ [*Epacris curtisiae*](#)

northwest heath
shrub to 1m high; to 6mm long, edges transparent, tip pointed; flowers white, tubular



GJ [*Epacris impressa*](#)

common heath
shrub; white, red or pink tubular flowers with dimples at base



GJ *Epacris lanuginosa*

swamp heath

erect narrow shrub to 1.5m; leaves narrow lance-shaped with sharp point; flowers white, tubular in clusters



GJ *Eucalyptus obliqua*

stringybark

tree to 90m; trunk & branches covered in soft, ridged bark; leaves very unsymmetrical;



GJ *Eucryphia lucida*

leatherwood

tree to 12m; leaves green above whitish below, ends blunt; flowers with 4 rounded white petals & numerous reddish stamens



GJ *Eucryphia milliganii*

dwarf leatherwood

shrub/small tree to 3m high; leaves opposite, oblong, shiny green above, whitish under; flowers white with numerous showy burgundy-tipped stamens



BC *Gompholobium huegelii*

common wedgepea

herb; pea flower yellow inside and blackish outside



GJ [Hakea epiglottis](#)

beaked needlebush

shrub to 3m high; leaves needle-like, sharply pointed, to 5cm long; flowers yellow, spider-like; fruit woody, S-shaped



GJ [Hibbertia empetrifolia](#)

scrambling guineaflower

shrub, scrambling to 2m high; leaves elliptic, to 8mm long, hairy; flowers yellow, 6mm diam, petals with notched tips



RS [Hibbertia procumbens](#)

spreading guineaflower

prostrate shrub spreading to 30cm; leaves to 2cm long, edges rolled under; flowers large, yellow very numerous

fruit hairy at base



GJ [*Leptospermum nitidum*](#)

shiny teatree
shrub to 4m; leaves shiny green, to 2cm. Elliptical; flowers
white large, 5 petals; fruit hard, scaly, flat-topped, 5 slits



GJ [*Leptospermum riparium*](#)

river teatree
shrub to 4m; narrow, rolled margins, to 25mm; flowers, white,
single; capsule 5 slits, convex top



GJ [*Leptospermum scoparium*](#)

common teatree
shrub to 4m; leaves to 2cm with prickly pointed tips; flowers
white; fruit with 5 slits, top convex, woody



BC [*Leucopogon collinus*](#)

white beardheath
shrub to 50cm; leaves with edges turned down; flowers tiny,
tubular, bearded inside, in clusters at ends of branches



BC [*Leucopogon virgatus*](#)

common beard-heath
shrub to 1 m; small white flowers; petals woolly above



GJ [*Lobelia pedunculata*](#)

matted lobelia
prostrate, ground-covering perennial herb; leaves small, round;
flowers white or blue, split tube



GJ [*Melaleuca squamea*](#)

swamp honeymyrtle
shrub to 3m; leaves to 8mm, hairy; flowers mauve/white in
terminal globular heads



GJ [*Melaleuca squarrosa*](#)

scented paperbark
shrub/tree to 6m; leaves to 8mm, ovate, pointed; flowers
yellow/cream in terminal bottle brushes



RW [*Monotoca glauca*](#)

goldey wood
shrub to 3m; leaves to 10mm, sharp points; flowers white, 5
petalled, in small groups



GJ *Nematolepis squamea*

subsp. squamea

satinwood

shrub/tree to 4 m; leaves to 8 cm, green upper surface, silvery below; flowers white/cream, 5 petals with prominent stamens.



RS *Nothofagus cunninghamii*

myrtle beech

tree to 50m; leaves roundish, new growth red; flowers inconspicuous



GJ *Oxylobium arborescens*

tall shaggy pea

shrub to 6m; leaves to 8cm. edges turned down, dark green above, silky under; pea flowers golden, in clusters



GJ *Parsonsia brownii*

twining silkpod

vigorous climbing vine; leaves to 10cm, lighter green under; flowers small, yellow/orange, in clusters

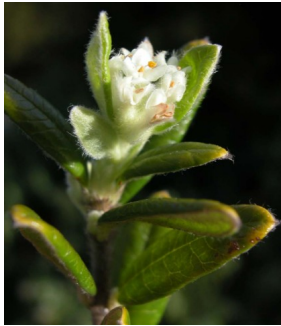

shrub; to 1.5 m tall; light green prickly leaves; delicate golden flowers



GJ *Philotheca virgata*

twiggly waxflower
shrub to 2m; stems warty; leaves narrow oblong to 2cm;
flowers white star-shaped, 4-5 petals

grey riceflower
shrub to 2m high; leaves opposite, elliptical, to 3cm long, flat;
flowers white, tubular, in few-flowered, terminal heads

cherry riceflower
shrub to 3m;

cheesewood
tree to 8m, conical habit; leaves dark green above, lighter
below; flowers bell-shaped, brown & yellow

hazel dogwood
shrub/tree to 15m; small branches densely rusty hairy; leaves to 12cm; rusty hairy under; flowers cream in bunches (panicles)



GJ [*Prostanthera lasianthos*](#)

christmas bush
shrub/small tree to 5m high; leaves to 8cm long, lance-shaped, dark green above, lighter under; flowers white to pale lilac, purple spots in throat, in showy clusters



RW [*Pultenaea juniperina*](#)

prickly beauty
shrub to 2.5m; leaves to 12mm, sharp pointed; golden pea flowers at ends of branches



GJ [*Richea pandanifolia*](#)

heath to 10m high; leaves strap-like, to 2m long; flowers white/pink maturing to deep pink, in spike to 25cm long



GJ [*Sprengelia incarnata*](#)

pink swampheath
erect shrub to 2m; leaves hard, pointed, sheathing stem; flowers pink/white, in terminal clusters



BC *Stylidium graminifolium*

narrowleaf triggerplant
herb to 50cm; leaves narrow, strap-like; flowers pink, four-petaled, in spikes



RS *Tasmannia lanceolata*

mountain pepper
tree to 5m; leaves lance-shaped on red stems; flowers yellow; fruit red turning black



GJ *Blechnum nudum*

fishbone waterfern
fronds light green divided only once, fertile fronds different



GJ *Blechnum wattsii*

hard waterfern
fronds dark green, divided only once, fertile fronds different



GJ *Dicksonia antarctica*

soft treefern
Tall fern, trunks to several metres tall



GJ *Microsorium pustulatum*

kangaroo fern
growing on trunks of other plants or rocks



GJ *Polystichum proliferum*

mother shieldfern
note bulbils (new FERN) on fronds



GJ *Pteridium esculentum*

subsp. *esculentum*
bracken
common fern to 2.5m tall; leathery much divided frond



GJ *Baloskion tetraphyllum*

southern cordrush
rush to 1m; leaves replaced by brown sheaths along flowering stems; flowers in terminal clusters



BC *Chiloglottis cornuta*

green bird-orchid
orchid with pair of opposite, broad ovate leaves; flowers green,
on scapes to 4cm high



BC [*Dianella tasmanica*](#)

forest flaxlily
